



We have heard the wording of a *deep state* being used in our society. Some link it to hypothetical ideals, and some link it to the underground and secretive governmental agencies. But what is our deep state? Where did it come from? Where did it all start? We will delve into this and find out exactly how all of this started and how it relates to historical things that have taken place.

### What is a Deep State?

A deep state, by definition from Miriam Webster, is an alleged secret network of specifically non-elected government officials. They may be individuals or private entities, as is found in the financial services and the defense industries. They operate extra-legally (which means not regulated or sanctioned by law) to influence and enact government policy. In other words - outside the established law.



The power of the deep state comes from experience, knowledge, relationships, insight, craft, special skills, traditions, and shared values. Together, these purported attributes make nameless bureaucrats into a super-government that is accountable to no one. This is a scary prospect.

The deep state requires coordinated efforts. If only one group was involved, it would not be as effective. But the deep state that exists in the United States is a very well thought out, coordinated effort. The hard part is to find out who's pulling strings. Is it possible that it might be somebody that's outside of our country? Could it be other governments or financial groups, or could it be powerful individuals banding together with a vested interest to see our power sapped from the global stage?

We're going to explore a few of the outside influences that seem to be instigating this in the next newsletter. We're also going to look at what we call the *modus operandi*, the method of operation that is used. For example, the group or the person that is controlling this behavior makes a phone call after having a meeting with all their cohorts. Then what do they do? They make a phone call to... Yes, it could be somebody in our government. Or they might call and work through the media. Maybe it is a legislator or a leader in an activist group to start the ball rolling. Sometimes it is a huge organization or a business that will lead the way.



It all depends on what they have for a goal. For example, let's say that you want to manipulate something like the real estate market or you would

like to influence a climate bill that is going to be introduced. The real estate market is relatively easy to affect. The media starts a story about something; people believe it and act accordingly. You might say something like the “Experts say, ‘housing market might get tight because interest rates might go up.’” Purely speculation on your part, but people are going to react to anything that affects their money. Or you might say that the stock market seems to be



wavering. Or perhaps you want to push public opinion on an expensive climate bill. Call the media and make alarming predictions.

The media can start rumors in ways that no one else can. Often they place their rumors directly on the news wire.

Then, many of the small and midsized papers, that do not have the financial wherewithal to have reporters everywhere, take their news directly off the wire. So one story can be released through the wire and spreads, gaining traction, exposing it to as many people as possible.


### An Effective Way to Change Markets or Minds

Rumor and innuendo are probably among the most effective ways to get people to behave in a certain way. And it does not bother certain news media to carry things that are not true or are not verified.

However, it is indeed easier to begin boldly by utilizing the President or somebody in his cabinet. They then can start the proceedings that will require all the agencies under the federal jurisdiction to comply. There is a vast number of agencies and commissions out there. The fact is we do not know for sure the total number, but we do know that there are between 400 and 500 of them. At least, that's as many as I had counted by hand that was listed. But a good many more are not listed. We know that they influence state and local agencies also in the process.

Now, these agencies have employees all over the country. They are following the mandates sent down

from whatever group that started them originally or from the leaders of the federal agency controls. **We the People will have to fix that.** By the definition given to us from USLegal.com, an administrative agency is a lawmaking body with limited powers delegated by Congress. They specialize in a specific issue that requires their expertise. This is progressivism in its purest form. They **believe** that agency personnel knows much more than we do; therefore, they can run the government and our lives much better than we can.



The rules and regulations that they create can be enforced as law. According to US law, the agencies aid the courts with speedy disposal of cases by circumventing the litigation processes. In 1946, the Administrative Procedure Act set the standards for how agencies exercise and delegate their lawmaking powers. This particular act was set up to govern



federal agencies and their method of issuing regulations. It required them to publish notices for the final rule-making in the Federal Register and provide opportunities for the public to comment on the notices of the proposed rule-making. There is a 30 day delayed effective date set for this purpose.

In contrast to federal administrative agencies, our states also have similar agencies to care for items such as transportation, education, public health, and labor laws. These agencies are mirror images of their federal counterparts; however, their main restriction

is that they may not issue any rule or regulation that goes against anything that of the federal counterpart issued.

Now, I'm sure that all of us run to the Federal Register for some light reading. However, unless the public is notified or is used to looking into this type of thing, many agency rulings come about unnoticed - at least until they impact us in some way. We have discussed agency behavior in a previous newsletter and hope that you take the time to read how they work. Another way to look at the deep state would be to say that it is a coordinated effort utilizing many variables to accomplish a set goal. Hitler was very good at using different groups to achieve what he wanted. He had bullying squads to intimidate the general public, political leaders, the judiciary, and opponents. He utilized the youth leagues to put pressure on their parents and friends to keep them in line. He also used the press, once he reopened it, to keep information consistently flowing in his favor.

He put out a standardized message to bring everyone in under his influence and keep them under his control. He was a dictator in a fascist regime. He used everything at his disposal to create the atmosphere that he wanted. Initially, when he came into power, the people loved him; they thought he would cure all of their financial ailments and woes. Guess what happens when you expect the government to fix all of your problems. Hitler promised to solve the country's economic issues



and keep the public safe from his illusionary enemies.

Hitler needed an enemy to point at and say, "This is the main reason that we're having all these problems." He used the Jewish population as part of that. He also used nationalism to get the people to think he had a right to take over other countries that Germany lost in World War I. He was a magnificent speaker and could work his audience into a fervor very easily. It wasn't until later, when they started to see how the Jewish people were being treated by his thugs and later by the military, that they realized their country was being strangled. By then, many in the country started to regret his climb to power. Too little too late.

He was considered a conservative because he preached protection, economy, love of country. But underneath, he was in love with himself and felt that he was born for extraordinary things. Here are a few quotes from the book he wrote while incarcerated for a coup he attempted early in his career; after which he became more stealthily.



"The question of the 'nationalization' of a people is, among other things, primarily a question of creating healthy social conditions as a foundation for the possibility of educating the individual. For only those who through school and upbringing learn to know the cultural, economic, but above all the political, greatness of their own fatherland can and unit achieve the inner pride in the privilege of being a member of such a people. **And I can fight only for something that I love, love only what I respect, and respect only what I at least know.**" That would be himself.

"What I knew of Social Democracy in my youth was exceedingly little and very inaccurate." Further on, he said, "Consequently, this activity of the Social Democracy was not displeasing to me. And the fact that it strove to improve the living conditions of the worker, as, in my innocence, I was still stupid enough to believe, likewise seemed to speak rather

for it than against it.” Then he said, “What most repelled me was its hostile attitude toward the struggle for the preservation of Germanism...”.

### ***But I digress.***

Hitler’s deep state was the utilization of everything in his control to accomplish what he wanted and to make people believe what he said, when he said it. Sound familiar? The general population could be looked at as being influenced and controlled by multiple avenues of influence that were pulling at the same thread.

So what happens within our government that accomplishes the same thing that Hitler was able to accomplish? First of all, our government has set up many different agencies that enforce their policies. They have executive, legislative, and judicial powers in their control over their area of concentration.

Now, let’s look at the hierarchy of the deep state within our world. Make no mistake, it is a global initiative with a ‘treacle down effect’ that is the primary cause leading to where we are today.

### **Leadership by the Elite or an Elitist**



Either you have a controlling central government (like ours with the five hundred agencies ), or you must have different control mechanisms in place. The Depression was one such mechanism. World Wars were another. The Covid Pandemic was yet another. These control mechanisms allowed an expansion of powers of many agencies in the name of the public's interest.

Oftentimes, to accomplish a small step in the overall plan, legislation is introduced through the House of Representatives or Senate. Sometimes by Presidential Executive Order. All of these can be what we call baby steps to get to the final goals.

Once the legislation is introduced and read, the media is used as a marketing tool to promote the need for the bill, whatever it may be. Social media, cultural influences, and political party pressures rally together to help the bills gain support and ultimately pass.

Once passed, there will be more media to convince us how wonderful it all is, and once again, a few more of our freedoms die as the global agenda advances *ONE MORE STEP*.
